Manipal University has always been at the forefront in encouraging student research. The Manipal University Student Research Forum (MUSRF) of Manipal College of Dental Sciences, Mangalore conducted a workshop on Forensic Dentistry on 11th April, 2016 titled “Bite of Crime”, which was attended by 270 delegates. This workshop is the third of the interactive series conducted by MUSRF since its inception, a year ago. **Dr. Ashith B. Acharya**, a pioneer of forensic odontology in India, was the resource person for the workshop and he delved into his experience in forensic odontology in identification and estimation of age, gender and bite marks. The hands-on workshop that followed gave the students an opportunity to practice digital methods of age estimation and bite mark identification.

The Chief Guest, **Dr. Sanjeev M. Patil**, Deputy Commissioner of Police, (Crime and Traffic) of



Mangalore City Police, gave a brief description of the crime scene and the importance of dental evidence in solving a crime. He also recommended inclusion of crime scene visitation as part of the dental curriculum.

RESTORENDO II: 2016



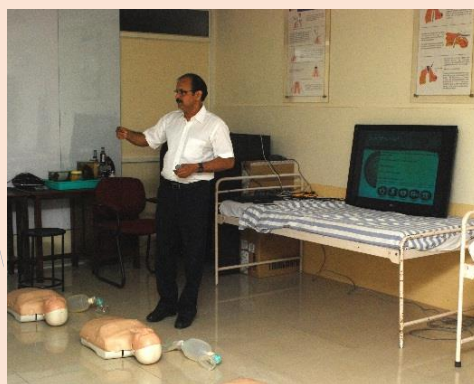

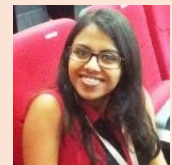


Ms. Fong Chia Ying

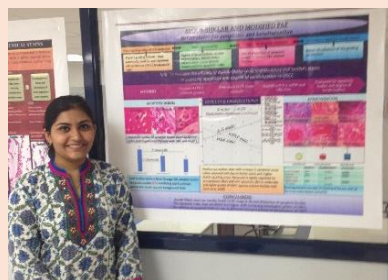

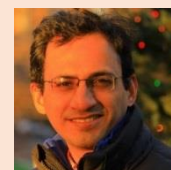

The Department of Oral Pathology guides students in the foundation of Oral Histology and Dental Anatomy (in the I B.D.S.) before they come to understand the manifestations of various

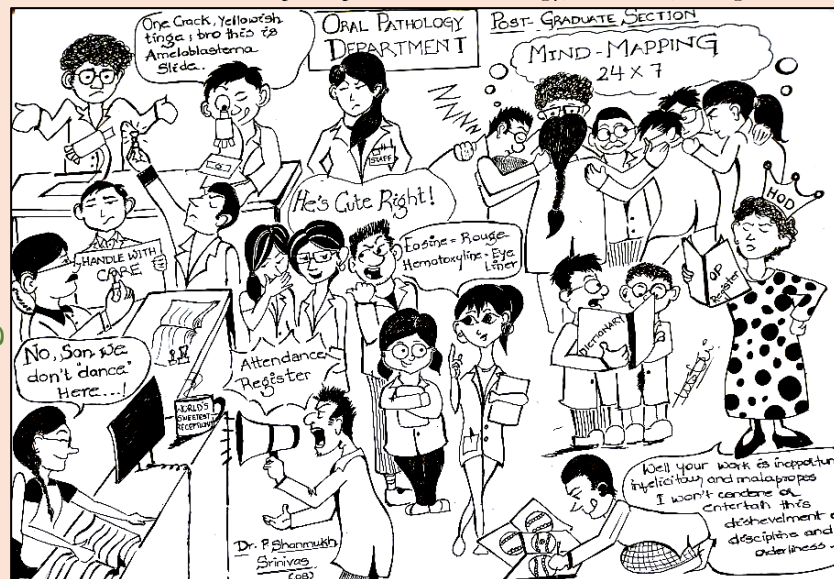
